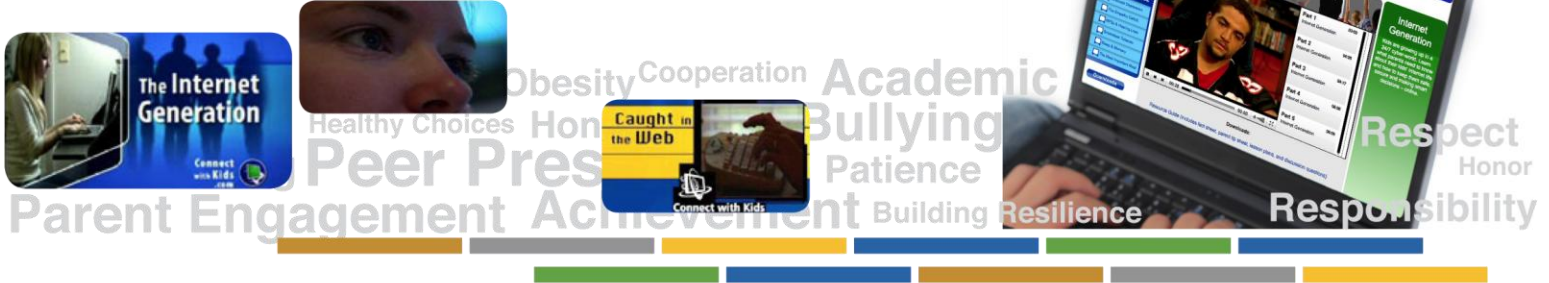

# Bullying Prevention on WebSource

## ON THE STUDENT CONNECTION

- *Sticks and Stones* – Middle and High Students: Cyberbullying
- *Civil Wars* – Elementary and Middle Students: Civility and a Culture of Caring
- *Silent Witness* – Middle and High School: The role of the silent majority that is neither bully nor victim in preventing bullying and building a culture of caring.
- *Invisible Weapons* – Elementary, Middle and High School Students: An Emmy®-award winning Connect with Kids presentation featuring interviews with both the bullies and the bullied.

Each video features five segments approximately 3-5 minutes in length for easy integration to the school day. The entire program can be taught in 15 sessions that are 15-30 minutes each, and includes both videos and lesson plans. Sessions can also be combined to create fewer sessions for a longer time period such as 7 to 8 sessions at 55 minutes each.

## ON THE PARENT CONNECTION

- *Baby Bullies* examines the roots of aggressive behavior and the need for prevention and early intervention.

## ON THE EDUCATOR CONNECTION: FOR TEACHERS, COUNSELORS AND PARENT COORDINATORS
